Now Enrolling: Anchor Study

Join us in researching an investigational medicine for children and adolescents with autism spectrum disorder

We are enrolling children and adolescents between ages 5-17 with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) in the Anchor Study. The purpose of this study is to determine the effectiveness of an investigational medication in reduced irritability associated with ASD. This is a double-blind trial meaning that half of the participants receive the active medication and half receive a tablet with no active medication.



STUDY SNAPSHOT:

- Study Duration: 8-12 weeks
- Total Study Visits: (4) in-person visits, (4) virtual visits and (1) follow-up phone call
- Participation will include 4 blood draws

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE:

- Individuals ages 5-17
- Have a diagnosis of ASD
- Show signs of irritability, involving verbal or physical outburst of anger, frustration or distress (including tantrum behavior and meltdowns)
