Now Enrolling: The Aurora Study

A clinical study using an investigational medication for core symptoms of autism spectrum disorder (ASD)

We are currently enrolling individuals between ages 15-45 who have a diagnosis of ASD to participate in a clinical study that aims to evaluate the effectiveness of an investigational medication to help treat social and/or communication deficits and symptoms of repetitive behaviors in individuals with ASD.

Study sponsored by Hoffmann-La Roche.



STUDY SNAPSHOT:

- (9) in-person visits to SARRC's 16th Street Campus completed over the course of 24 weeks (12 weeks on medication, 6 weeks follow up).
- Participants will need a study partner to attend all visits (someone who lives with or spends 20+ hours per week with them).
- Participants will receive \$100 per visit, for up to a total of \$900. Study partners will get \$90 per visit, up to \$810 total.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE:

- Individuals with autism ages 15-45.
- Provide written informed consent.
- Have a parent or other support person to attend clinic visits and provide information about behavior and symptoms, and oversee procedures and medication dosing.
