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Agreement

- A. Organization will contribute {EITHER 100% of the net proceeds of the event (i.e., total revenues less actual out-of-pocket costs incurred) OR a guaranteed minimum amount of \$ _____ } to Southwest Autism Research & Resource Center, along with a written accounting of event revenues and expenses within thirty (30) days after the event.
- B. Any use of the Marks is subject to the prior written approval of the Southwest Autism Research & Resource Center. Accordingly, the Sponsoring Organization agrees to submit to Southwest Autism Research & Resource Center — prior to distribution, broadcast or publication thereof — all printed material, publicity releases and advertising relating to the Event, which mentions Southwest Autism Research & Resource Center or contains the Marks; as well as a list of this material’s distribution and/or destination points (i.e., where it will be aired, printed, mailed, posted, etc.) In addition, the Sponsoring Organization understands that soliciting outside Southwest Autism Research & Resource Center’s territory is prohibited, and will result in termination of this and any future agreements between the Sponsoring Organization and Southwest Autism Research & Resource Center. Please acknowledge that a representative of Southwest Autism Research & Resource Center has discussed this issue with the Sponsoring Organization by having a representative of the Sponsoring Organization indicate a commitment to comply by initialing this paragraph: _
- C.
