Southwest Autism Research & Resource Center's (SARRC) Employment Services is for individuals 16 years or older who have been diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder (ASD).

SARRC's Employment Services is focused on building skills to prepare for competitive employment through vocational assessments, social and adaptive skills training, and volunteer opportunities and internships. Individuals who complete our program are better equipped with the skills needed to prepare for a job, enter into competitive, community-based employment and maintain employment.

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SARRC'S EMPLOYMENT INITIATIVE

At SARRC, adults with ASD gain experience and knowledge through career assessments, one-on-one sessions, internships, and on-the-job support. Beyond their first day of employment, SARRC partners with employers to identify and develop natural supports in the work environment.
