



Research Study About the Experiences of Adolescents and Young Adults with Autism

We are interviewing adolescents and young adults with autism, their caregivers, and other stakeholders about the transition to adulthood. Responses from these interviews will be used to inform the development of a new intervention for youth with autism.

ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS

- Adolescents and adults (13 to 30 years) with a documented autism spectrum disorder diagnosis from a licensed clinician
- Verbal IQ of 70 or above
- Have a parent or caregiver who is willing to participate in the study

STUDY PROCEDURES

- 3-hour visit at SARRC to complete assessments and participate in an interview about transition-related experiences
