First Place Transition Academy Outcomes Evaluation Study

Are you an adult with autism who is interested in advancing research?

Southwest Autism Research & Resource Center (SARRC) is currently enrolling adults with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) ages 18 and older to participate in a study that aims to compare the outcomes of 100 autistic adults who are currently enrolled or who are graduates of the First Place Transition Academy in Phoenix.

Participants will attend two virtual or in-person meetings with SARRC's team as part of the community sample group led by Arizona State University, SARRC and First Place AZ to help investigators understand the efficacy of the two-year Academy program that is designed to build crucial independent living and career-readiness skills among adults with ASD.



STUDY PARTICIPATION WILL INVOLVE:

- Must be 18 or older with a diagnosis of autism
- Attending two virtual or in-person sessions
- Not a current or former First Place Transition Academy student
- Study participants will receive a gift card for their participation
- Plan on three hours to complete all study-related activities
