

## Now Enrolling: The Aurora Study

*A clinical study using an investigational medication for core symptoms of autism spectrum disorder (ASD)*

We are currently enrolling individuals between ages 15-45 who have a diagnosis of ASD to participate in a clinical study that aims to evaluate the effectiveness of an investigational medication to help treat social and/or communication deficits and symptoms of repetitive behaviors in individuals with ASD.

### STUDY SNAPSHOT:

- (9) in-person visits to SARRC's 16th Street Campus completed over the course of 24 weeks (12 weeks on medication, 6 weeks follow up)
- Participants will need a study partner to attend all visits (someone who lives with or spends 20+ hours per week with them)
- Participants will receive \$150 per visit, for up to a total of \$1,350
- Study partners will get \$125 per visit, up to \$1,125 total

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Individuals with autism ages 15-45
- Provide written informed consent
- Have a parent or other support person (study partner) to attend clinic visits and provide information about behavior and symptoms, and oversee procedures and medication dosing
