WHY SUPPORT AUTISM?

Autism spectrum disorder (ASD) impacts 1 in 36 children in the U.S. occurring in all racial, ethnic, and socioeconomic groups. Roughly 80% of individuals with ASD are younger than 22, and in the next 10 to 15 years as many as 500,000 will age into adulthood nationwide. Moving forward, it will be critical to ensure that individuals have access to a lifetime of services, resources, and support to maximize independence, increase self-sufficiency, and achieve success long-term.
