

Now Enrolling: Leucovorin Study

A 16-week clinical trial to learn more about language and social communication in children with autism spectrum disorder (ASD).

Southwest Autism Research & Resource Center (SARRC) is collaborating with Dr. Richard Frye in enrolling families of children ages 2.5-5 years with ASD to partake in a double-blind, placebo-controlled clinical trial.

The purpose of this study is to assess the efficacy of an investigational natural treatment known as Levoleucovorin in enhancing language and social communication skills in children diagnosed with ASD.

STUDY SNAPSHOT:

- A total of (8) study visits (12 weeks on medication) that includes:
 - (1) in-person screening visit
 - (7) study visits
 - 3 in-person
 - 4 remote

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Enrolling participants ages 2.5-5 years old
- A diagnosis of ASD
- No history of seizures or other significant medical conditions that require immediate care

In-person visits take place at SARRC's campus located at 2225 N 16th St Phoenix, AZ 85006
