Now Enrolling: STALICLA Study

We are currently enrolling individuals with autism, ages 12 to 65, who have a diagnosis of macrocephaly or can provide documented head circumference data taken at any point after birth and before 24 months of age.

The STALICLA study aims to identify unique characteristics in individuals with autism through laboratory testing, potentially paving the way for a more personalized approach to medicine.



STUDY SNAPSHOT:

- Participation includes one, two-hour study visit at our 16th St. Campus (2225 N 16th St., Phoenix, AZ 85006)
- A singular blood draw
- Assessments to help define subtypes.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Enrolling participants ages 12-65 years old
- A diagnosis of autism, and of macrocephaly, or be willing to provide a well-documented head circumference at any time after birth and before 24 months of age
