Every two years, Southwest Autism Research & Resource Center (SARRC) hosts Swirl, Sip & Savor—a distinctive wine and food pairing experience benefiting our **Think Autism®** program. The proceeds from *Swirl, Sip & Savor* supports research and programs creating awareness, early diagnosis, and solutions for individuals with autism and their families.

Developed for parents, educators and medical professionals, Think Autism is designed for children ages 8-13 and offers resources in all 50 states. Our Social Challenges Screening Questionnaire can identify children who may have symptoms that were once characterized as Asperger's syndrome, but now Asperger's is part of autism spectrum disorder. These children have significant social impairments that markedly affect their functioning and overall well-being, but language develops on time and there is no associated cognitive impairment.

The app also features informational videos from the unique perspectives of professionals in the field, a parent, and a person with autism. If more individual support is needed, you will have the option to connect with an expert at SARRC located in Phoenix, Ariz. Our team will outline the next steps and connect people to resources in their area.

Swirl, Sip & Savor is a step in the direction of not only creating awareness of autism but will lead the way in the development of early screening and diagnostic tools including our newly launched **Think Autism mobile app**.
