Difficulties with communication and social interaction are common issues for those with autism

We are currently enrolling individuals, ages 12 to 17, who have an autism diagnosis that experience difficulties with communication and social interactions.

The IRIS Study aims to find out whether an investigational drug might improve the symptoms of ASD that often make social interaction challenging.

To qualify, participants must:

- Be 12 to 17 years of age
- Have a diagnosis of autism
- Have a parent or guardian who is willing to assist during the study and attend clinic visits at our campus (2225 N. 16th St., Phoenix)

There is no cost to participate, and compensation for time and travel may be available.
