

# STUDY FOR MALES WITH FRAGILE X AGES 13 TO 45

*The purpose of this study is to evaluate the safety, efficacy and tolerability of an investigational study medication to see if it can help improve cognition in males aged 13-45 with FXS*

## STUDY PARTICIPATION WILL INVOLVE:

- A total of (8) study visits that include:
  - **One** in-person screening visit at our campus
  - **Five** study treatment visits (3 in person and 2 by phone)
  - **Two** post-study follow-up phone calls

## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE:

- Male participants ages 13-45
- Participant must be able to swallow a capsule
- Must weigh at least 86 lbs and have a Body Mass Index (BMI) between 18 and 40
- Participant must have a diagnosis of FXS
